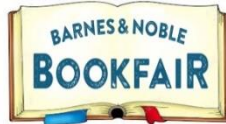

BARNES & NOBLE BOOK FAIR ~ Hope Lutheran School will host a Barnes & Noble Book Fair on Saturday, November 11th. All sales (*when Hope Lutheran School is mentioned*) count toward receiving a percentage of sales for our school. This even includes ebooks, online orders, and purchases made in the Barnes & Noble Café. We will earn 15% on the total sales up to \$1,999.00 and 20% for sales over \$2000.00. Funds raised support our library.



If you are unable to visit the store that day, purchases made from November 11th to the 15th will also be credited to our school – but you must remember to mention Hope Lutheran School at the time of purchase.

In addition to shopping in any Barnes & Noble store, book fair supporters can shop online at BN.COM/bookfairs from November 11th to the 15th by entering book fair ID 12177390 at check out. Online shopping is a great way for family, friends, and supporters to participate in the book fair, especially if they live out of town. When ordering online, remember to enter our event number.

* Students will sing at 1:00 p.m. and should wear their team shirts to Barnes & Noble that day.

* We need students and parents to hand out reminders to customers so we can receive a portion of their purchase. A sign-up sheet for volunteers will be located on the bulletin board in the hallway by the red doors.

- **BARNES & NOBLE** \$10 and \$25 cards are available. This is a great way to "double dip" at the book fair. Our school earns 8% of the price of the Scrip card and also a percentage of the purchase at Barnes & Noble!

EASY WAYS TO RAISE MONEY FOR OUR SCHOOL ~

Hope benefits by your participation in the following programs:

- ★ **Box Top\$ for Education** - It's easy to participate. Most General Mills products have the "Box Top\$" on them. This is a great way to earn money for Hope with your regular grocery shopping. Students should give Box Top\$ to their teacher.
- ★ **Smith's Food and Drug**— You can support our school through this program by linking your rewards card to Hope. Link your Smith's Rewards Card at smithscommunityrewards.com. If you do not have a Smith's card, they are available at Smith's customer service desk.
- ★ **Fred Meyer**—You can help Hope Lutheran School earn donations just by shopping with your Fred Meyer Rewards Card. Sign up for the Community Rewards program by linking your Fred Meyer Rewards Card to Hope Lutheran School at www.fredmeyer.com/communityrewards. You can search for us by name, or by our non-profit number 81850
- ★ **Scrip** ~ Scrip is just a funny word that equates to gift cards from national and local retailers. They are the same gift cards that you can buy at stores. If you buy a card for \$25 for Wal-mart, it costs you \$25. There are no hidden or extra fees to sign up. Then Scrip donates a percentage of your purchase to our school. It's that simple! Just use Scrip cards to do your regular shopping (groceries, gas, clothing, etc.). All it takes is a little planning ahead.



How do you participate? A scrip order sheet may be found on the table outside the office. The order form lists many of the merchants who participate in Scrip. You might be surprised by the number of businesses that you frequent that are on the list. Simply fill out the form, attach payment, and return to the form to the office. Or you may order online by going to www.shopwithscrip.com. (The list of participating retailers is much longer on Scrip's website.) Our enrollment number is: **BF329B4D18433**.

Scrip orders will be placed on the first and third Monday of each month. Orders need to be received in the office (or ordered online) by 11:00 Monday mornings. Scrip cards are usually received in a week.

New this year: we have a number of cards on hand from a variety of merchants. Just ask in the office if we have cards from the merchant you need and you can purchase them on the spot! If you have questions about Scrip, please contact the office.
