Provide a safe and secure Christcentered, family atmosphere for academic learning and living via <u>Classical Education</u> time-tested and better

We believe in a comprehensive approach to student education that encourages and develops a child's mental, emotional, spiritual and physical growth. A variety of classroom experiences emphasize the building of knowledge, communication skills and application of facts to problems solving i.e., *learning how to learn* and student ownership.

Special field trips (e.g., Yellowstone National Park, Camp Perkins, etc.) expand our classrooms into "real world" experiences where students can validate fundamental truths and anchor their learning capabilities.

Our goal is to equip students with:

- time-tested moral truths and experience their application in daily living
- the ability to critically evaluate challenges and problem solve
- effective communication skills

Finally, students learn best when they feel safe and secure and Hope's Safety and Security program does just that or students, parents and staff.

"Classical Learning"

Classical Education is a **time-tested educational** methodology that teaches factual information and develops a student's ability to <u>understand</u> how to learn.

When students know how to learn, they can go to any field, subject or situation and know how to excel. Classical Education implements investigative thinking to help anchor students with fundamental truths and values. Students are invited to learn the basics, test the systems and freely communicate their conclusions or observations. This three-fold approach to learning is referred to as the **Trivium**.



The Challenge

Like any private christian school we cannot charge the tuition amount to families we require in order to sustain our amazing school & ministry to the community without help from people like you. Right now the operating cost per student is around \$10,500.00 per year.

What to do

Normally, student tuition has covered a significant portion of our operational costs, but it never covered the entire budget expenses even when we were at "full" enrollment. Historically the congregation has been able to supplement the budget shortfalls when we were at full enrollment.

Unfortunately, the budget shortfall has been around \$100,000 to \$150,000/yr. and we were forced to develop a new funding strategy.



The Solution

Developing and employing resources are vital for the continuance of our service to the community. Additionally, it was witnessing the positive impacts that Christian education has had on our students, their families and the community at large, that **compelled us to do everything possible to** keep this educational ministry available for another 60 plus years.

About six years ago we decided to **modify our funding model** to include the community we serve. We sought financial support from <u>likeminded individuals</u> who value Christian education and Classical Learning and <u>"YOU responded"</u>.

Your continued support is the critical action that allows this school to operate, improve our educational programs and continue to grow enrollment. While providing for other necessities, your generous donation will also:
