### Confession and Absolution

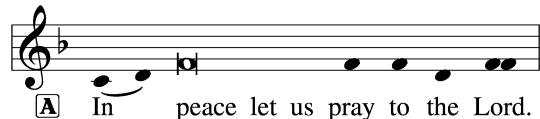
- P** If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

- P** Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment.
